Vitamin D is a fat-soluble vitamin that the body produces when the skin is exposed to ultraviolet light (specifically UVB) from the sun. The skin, the liver, and the kidneys are all involved in vitamin D production. Vitamin D works in concert with other nutrients and minerals in maintaining the health of the bones and teeth. In fact, vitamin D helps facilitate the absorption and assimilation of several essential inorganic elements: calcium, magnesium, iron, selenium, zinc, and copper. Cholecalciferol (Vitamin D3) also assists maintenance of bone mineralization by regulating calcium and phosphorus homeostasis. Not only is vitamin D necessary for bone growth and maintenance of bone density, but it also demonstrates effects on the immune, endocrine, and cardiovascular systems. Furthermore, vitamin D may play an important role in regulating cell differentiation which could be why observational studies have noted associations between poor vitamin D status and increased risk of breast and colorectal cancer.<sup>i</sup>

Vitamin D deficiency can be prevalent in certain populations, geographical locations, and is also noticed in several disease states, including the following: cancer, osteoporosis, osteopenia, multiple sclerosis, vitiligo, Crohn's disease, rheumatoid arthritis, Sjogren's syndrome, diabetes, metabolic syndrome, psoriasis, seasonal affective disorder, fibromyalgia, Parkinson's, arteriosclerosis, osteoarthritis, IBS, and more.

#### **ABOUT THE INGREDIENTS:**

Both vitamin D and vitamin K are necessary for optimal bone health. Vitamin K is an essential cofactor involved in bone metabolism, blood coagulation, prevention of vessel remineralization, and regulation of several cellular functions.<sup>II</sup> Vitamin K2 (also called MK-7®) may increase osteocalcin levels which can help reduce spine fracture risk. Furthermore, according to a 2017 study, "Treating osteoporotic patients with vitamin K might have the additional advantage of protecting arteries from vascular calcification through its action on MGP, a vitamin K dependent protein with anticalcific properties." (Fusaro, 2017). <sup>III</sup>

Aside from skeletal health, this fat soluble vitamin is important for blood clotting and cardiovascular health.\* Dietary sources of vitamin K1 include leafy green vegetables, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, lettuce, spinach, etc. Dietary sources of K2 include eggs from free-range chickens, grass-fed meat and dairy.
